A Few Updates

As we get closer to the summer I wanted to quickly remind everyone of some some approaching deadlines to sign up for our trips. But before that I wanted to give a few updates/reminders on a few things. If your child is going to CBH then you should have received an email this week about changes to their schedule.

They are going to operate at 50% capacity and do this by making each session a one week session that is either high school only or 5-8th graders. Essentially our high schoolers (whether 3rd or 5th session) will go to their camp their normal week, and the junior high group will go the week after. There are still plenty of logistics to work through, but we'll come up with a plan as we get closer and should have one ready by our Summer Kickoff Cookout (which you should sign up for if you haven't!) If you are a parent that is going to any of the sessions and would be willing to drive please let me know. I will more than likely be teaching one of the 5th session camps, but currently do not know which one. Regardless, after last year we will just be glad to have camp this year even if it is a little different. There is potential to do some different things to cater to an older or young audience depending on the session. If you have any questions feel free to reach out to

May 31st - [Summer Kickoff Cookout](#)

This is for incoming 6th grade-freshman. We will end up performing a variety of service projects in Amarillo, some of what we can do may be limited but I think we proved over Spring Break that there is plenty of work to be done in our area.. I do not know what housing will exactly look like, but at this time I am planning to **be in need of host homes to house the kids over this week.**

June 13th-18th - [HS Mission Arlington](#) - \$120 (by May 31st)/\$100 (by May 16th)

As stated in the opening article, Opportunity Camp is not going to be possible for this summer. Instead we are going to be working with Mission Arlington. I would equate them to Faith City Missions in Amarillo and we will be running a VBS in apartment complexes in their area. One of the things that I am most excited for is that this is much more student led than Opportunity Camp was so while **I would love to have at least three other adults accompany me on the trip**, they will mainly be there for supervision and driving vans. We will be working Monday-Thursday and will go to **Six Flags** on Friday before coming home.

For our mystery trip, we load up the incoming 7th graders to freshman in vans early in the morning and spend the day somewhere within four hours of here.
