Ukraine Update (from Virginia Stubbs)

Dnipro (where we work and stayed in Dec/Jan) was hit by three air strikes last night (Thursday night). Food is beginning to be harder to get where Sasha is in Chernivtsi. They still feed over 50 people a day and are only allowed 2 of each item at the store, so they take extra people to buy food and fill the van. Christian men in the West drive every day to pick up refugees from the train stations coming from the east. Every day they get together as a group and pray, sing, have a devo and speak about feelings with each other. It is the new normal. Continue to pray. I am getting money to them every day. Pray for relief and peace. Pray for wisdom.
