5 To Him who made the heavens with skill,

For His lovingkindness is everlasting;

The Psalmist continues on through this psalm recounting all of the incredible things God has done for his people. I wonder if we sat down and wrote out all the things God has done for us what it might sound like? Maybe it would sound something like:

God has blessed my life beyond what I deserve,

His love never ends.

He has molded me and shaped me in his image,

His love never ends.

He sent His Son to die for me,

His love never ends.

He blesses me with life day in and day out

His love never ends.

I encourage you as we head into the Thanksgiving holiday to spend some time writing a "Psalm." I encourage you to model it after Psalm 136 and repeat a common line after every line.
