Buff Notes

Augustine was a philosopher in the late 300s/early 400s. Although his mother was a Christian he wasn't easily convinced of the Christian faith. To him, the stories of the Old Testament seemed morally flawed. He felt that the Christian faith was crude and full of mysteries. He sought out others who could give him sound and logical teaching. He tried out other faiths and beliefs. At age 31 he was finally converted and baptized into Christ. After his baptism, he became a prolific writer commenting on scripture, refuting other beliefs (including some that he once claimed). He wrote something of an autobiography titled *Confessions*. In this work, Augustine lays out his innermost heart and mind and methodically details his life from a spiritual perspective. He was a man who was searching for truth, and it took him 31 years to finally come to the truth that can only be found in Christ. In his work *Confessions* Augustine begins with a prayer, I want you to read the words he uses as they are so significant.

Great are You, O Lord, and greatly to be praised;
great is Your power, and of Your wisdom there is
no end. And man, being a part of Your creation,
desires to praise You — man, who bears about
with him his mortality, the witness of his sin, even
the witness that You resist the proud — yet man,
this part of Your creation, desires to praise You.
You move us to delight in praising You; for You
have made us for Yourself, and **our hearts are
restless until they rest in You.**

Does your heart feel restless? I encourage you: rest in God, he is the author and creator of Truth. Psalm 62:1: "Truly my soul finds rest in God; my salvation comes from him."

Matthew 11:28-29: "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." ---C. Herron
